

## Oneworld among latest Siewcharran grant recipients

Oneworld Publications, the Orange Tree Theatre in Richmond and Theatre Dell in Sheffield are the latest recipients of grants from the Mo Siewcharran Fund.



The grants are in memory of former Nielsen Books director Mo Siewcharran, who died in June 2017, and are administered by Creative Access. Her husband, John Seaton, said: "Mo was passionate about both theatre and publishing and felt strongly about supporting people from non-white backgrounds. We were thrilled with the level of interest from organisations in this round of applications and are looking forward to supporting many more young BAME candidates to pursue their careers over the coming years."

At Oneworld, the grant will support an editorial intern. Publisher Juliet Mabey said: "We are thrilled to be partnering with Creative Access, who have been such a brilliant force working to make creative industries like ours open to all, and honoured to be doing so thanks to a generous grant from the Mo Siewcharran Fund. Together, we can transform publishing so that it is truly representative of the readers it serves, as it should be."
